RILE / JILE is an interdisciplinary journal of the Association for the Study of Literature and Environment (ASLE-Brasil), whose main objective is to promote humanistic dialogues on environmental issues. The Journal publishes research articles, interviews, artistic works on literature, history, politics and art, focusing on subjects involving Brazil, Latin America, Asia, Africa, Australia and New Zealand.

The Journal has publications in digital and printed format of literary texts, articles and critical reviews in Portuguese, Spanish and English, as well as translations to Portuguese of foreign authors in the area. The articles will be published following the principles of the norms of the Brazilian Association of Technical Norms (ABNT). Collaborations have to be unpublished. They may also be republished in case they are in a foreign language and translated as authorized by the authors or publishers. Submissions should follow an ongoing process throughout the year.
